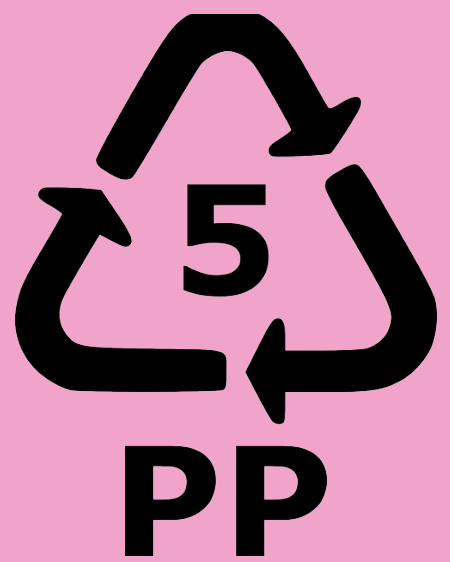

Tip #1

Use polypropylene bags or PP storage containers. How can you tell if your container is Polypropylene? It will have a marking like the one shown. PP containers will ensure your melts won't transfer scent.





Tip # 2

Use a high wattage warmer or a tealight warmer. The hotter temperatures will ensure a stronger scent.





Tip # 3

Use a smaller amount of wax in your warmer. We recommend a half to 1 oz at a time. This will ensure your warmer can reach the appropriate temperatures.



Tip # 4

Keep used wax to make a DIY candle. It won't have much scent left but it will be a good emergency candle.





Tip # 5

**Use a silicone dish for easier removal.
The silicone is made to withstand hot temperatures and is flexible enough to allow an easy removal of the cooled wax.**
